- One new and one used ball will be provided for each game. Additional used balls may be used if necessary.
- Balls that go out of play on an over throw: a player going to first base will advance to second base. All other baserunners get the base they were going to only.
- No Metal Cleats
- League tournament will begin on August 17<sup>th</sup>. All teams will play in a single elimination tournament
  - Teams will be seeded based upon their record from the regular season
- Catchers will use the orange mat placed in front of home plate for plays at home.
- Infield Fly Rule: a fair fly ball that can be caught by an infielder with ordinary effort and when there are runners on first and second or first, second and third bases with less than two outs.
- Once a runner passes the half-way line between 3<sup>rd</sup> and home they must go home and all plays at home are a force out, no tags. If a courtesy runner is needed, the last player who made an out must be used.
- Pitching arc limits are 6'-14'. The batter still has the option to hit a ball an umpire calls illegal. If the batter swings the ball no longer is called illegal.
- Players must be 35 years old or older. Each team may have three people 31 or older.
- No leading off, sliding or diving into bases. Players who leave the base before the ball is hit will be called out. The only exception is if an injury occurs.
- 60' bases and 50' pitching rubber
- Each team is expected to report the scores to their game by the end of the night to the concession stand so stands can be kept track of.
- Fair or Foul Ball: The position of the fielder's body or feet, have absolutely nothing to do with judging whether a ball is fair or foul. The judgment is based solely upon the relationship between the BALL and the LINE at the moment the fielder touches the ball, or at the moment the ball comes to a stop, or on outfield fly balls; the moment it touches the fielder or the ground. An outfield fly ball is judged to be fair or foul by the relationship of the ball to the foul line at the moment it first touches the ground, or where it first touches a fielder. If the ball touches a fielder in-flight, the judgment is made at where the ball was when it was touched, NOT from where it may land after a miss, or drop of the ball, by a fielder. The position of the fielder is irrelevant. You only focus on the ball and the foul line.
