

**VILLAGE OF MARSHALL
ORDINANCE 2015-04**

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED IN THE NE¼ OF THE SE¼ OF SECTION 9, T8N, R12E, TOWN OF MEDINA, DANE COUNTY, WISCONSIN TO THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALL.

WHEREAS, the Village has purchased land in the Town of Medina adjacent to land within the Village boundaries currently owned by the Village and intended for use as commercial property; and

WHEREAS, both the purchased lands and the remainder of the Village of Marshall are located wholly within Dane County; and

WHEREAS, §66.0223, Wis. Stats. expressly authorizes a municipality to annex any property it owns lying near or contiguous to its boundaries by adoption of an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that annexation of said lands to the Village of Marshall will serve the public interest by subjecting said lands to the ordinances and enforcement capabilities of the Village and by allowing the Village greater control over decisions affecting the property;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of Marshall, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section 1: Territory annexed. In accordance with sec. 66.0223 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the following described territory is hereby detached from the Town of Medina and annexed to the Village of Marshall, Wisconsin as part of the second (2nd) ward:

Lot 1, Certified Survey Map Number 4678, Being part of the NE¼ of the SE¼ of Section 9, T8N, R12E, Town of Medina, Dane County, Wisconsin described as follows:

Village of Marshall owns lot 1, CSM 4678, excepting the Southerly 33 feet within STH 19, conveyed to DOT in Document number 3235297.

Lands intended for annexation are to original CSM Lot boundary, or centerline of highway.


Section 2: Effect of Annexation. From and after the effective date of this ordinance, the territory described above shall be a part of the Village of Marshall for any and all purposes and such lands, and all persons entering upon such lands, shall be subject to the applicable ordinances, rules and regulations governing persons and lands within the Village of Marshall.

Section 3: Filing. The Village Clerk is directed to promptly file with the Secretary of State, seven (7) certified copies of this ordinance together with seven (7) copies of a plat showing the boundaries of the territory annexed. Within ten (10) days after the certified copies are filed, the Village Clerk shall mail or deliver a copy of this ordinance and the plat to the Dane County Clerk.

Section 4: Severability: If any provision of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstances, is determined to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 5: Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon its enactment and the filing of this ordinance in accordance with Section 3 hereof.
