ORDINANCE 2019-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 7, CHAPTER 14, SECTION 1
DOG PARK- PERMITS REQUIRED

Ordinance amendment introduced by: The Marshall Parks and Recreation Director-

Purpose of ordinance amendment: The Parks Committee recommends to the Village Board to enforce an annual or daily permit for the use of the dog park.


The Village Board of the Village of Marshall, Dane County, Wisconsin ordain as follows that Title 7 Chapter 14, Section 1 shall be amended as follows:

SEC 7-14-1 Dog Park- Permits Required


- (a) **Permit Required.** All dog park participants must purchase an annual or daily permit for use in the designated dog park area located in Village parks. Fees are determined in the Marshall Parks Event Fee Schedule.
- (b) **Definitions.** Designated dog park areas are any areas within a Village park set aside for use as an off leash dog park where the use has been approved by the Parks Committee.
- (c) **Revenue Allocation.** The revenue from the permit fees shall be put in a segregated fund to be used for the establishment and maintenance of the dog park. The permit fees shall be established by the Parks Committee and subject to approval by the Village Board of Trustees.
- (d) **Penalties.** Any person violating this ordinance in any 12 month period shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50) for the first offense and not less than fifty dollars (\$50) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100) for the second offense in any 12 month period; any person violating any provision of this section for the third time in a twelve-month period may be subject to a forfeiture of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200); any person violating any provision of this section for the fourth and subsequent time in a twelve-month period may be subject to a forfeiture of not less than two hundred dollars (\$200) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300).
- (e) **Officials Authorized to Issue Citation.** Citations authorized in Section 7-14-1 above may be issued by law enforcement officers and the Parks and Recreation Director of the Village with respect to sections of this code. These officials granted with the authority to issue citations under this section may delegate the authority to other Village employees with the approval of the Village board.
