VILLAGE OF MARSHALL RESOLUTION 2019-06

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE VILLAGE OF MARSHALL'S DESIRE TO STRIVE TOWARDS RENEWABLE ENERGY POLICIES AND PRACTICES

WHEREAS, the Village of Marshall is committed to energy independence

WHEREAS, renewable energy is a considerable factor in economic development and increasing value and quality of life within the community; and

WHEREAS, the Village's energy use could be served by existing renewable energy technologies at a cost equal to, or less than, traditional energy sources; and

WHEREAS, improving energy efficiency will result in cost savings for all Village residents; and

WHEREAS, use of renewable energy sources, paired with energy storage, and/or backed up by renewable co-generation, is an important strategy to build disaster resilience in the Village; and

WHEREAS, achieving a renewable energy future will require concerted action from individuals and the community, in urban and rural areas, from local and state governments, and from businesses and utilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Village establishes goals to meet 60 percent of all Village operations energy needs with renewable energy by 2030, 80 percent by 2035, and 100 percent by 2040; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village establishes goals to meet 33 percent of communitywide energy needs with renewable energy by 2030, 66 percent by 2040, and 100 percent by 2050; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village will utilize the Capital improvement plan to implement cost effective energy efficiency measures throughout Village operations including, but not limited to, buildings, equipment and fleet vehicles; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village will develop a resiliency plan to reduce vulnerability to main electric grid failure; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village will prioritize community-based development of renewable energy in Dane and surrounding Counties; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village will collaborate with other governmental and public entities locally and regionally to facilitate all energy measures
