Resolution Declaring a State of Emergency

Whereas, a novel strain of the coronavirus, named COVID-19, has spread throughout numerous countries including the United States; and

Whereas, the World Health Organization has declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern; and

Whereas, the United States Department of Health and Human Services has declared a Public Health Emergency; and

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has declared a Public Health Emergency; and

Whereas, on March 16, Dane County declared a State of Emergency; and


Whereas, the conditions created by the proclamation of these public health emergencies pose a continuing and substantial threat to public order, life, health and safety of the citizens of the Village of Marshall; and

Whereas, these conditions are requiring a multi-agency response.

Now therefore, it is hereby proclaimed, that pursuant to Wis. Stat. 323.11 and 323.14(4)(b), in order to protect the public peace, health and safety, preserve lives and property, economic stability, and insure cooperation and coordination, a Declaration of Local State of Emergency is imposed and shall remain in effect until such time as the COVID-19 is no longer a state and county emergency.

THIS DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY enacted this 14th day of April, 2020.
