April 2018 was tornado and severe weather awareness month. With that being said, I wanted to take this opportunity to inform residents about our emergency response plan for the Village of Marshall in the case of a tornado and/or severe weather.

As part of our emergency response plan the Marshall Village Hall is utilized as a shelter facility. In the event of a tornado and/or severe weather citizens can come to the village hall to take shelter during and after regular business hours. After business hours, our officers have been instructed during tornados and/or severe weather to open the main door of the Marshall Village Hall for public access. Shelter can be taken in the hallways and the conference room of the village hall until the severe weather subsides. If severe weather damages your home and makes it uninhabitable, other back-up shelter facilities are available as part of our emergency response plan.

I understand that most single-family homes have basements; therefore we always recommend you take shelter in your basement during tornados and/or severe weather. However, some homes, such as mobile homes, do not have basements and we encourage you to utilize the village hall as a shelter, if needed, and you can do so in a safe manner.
