SEC. 9-4-1 PRIVATE SEWER AND WATER LINE MAINTENANCE.

Every property owner in the Village shall pay for all service and maintenance on water or sewerage lines deemed to be the private line of the property connecting his business, home, apartment or any other building to the sewerage line and system belonging to and owned by the Village. Service and maintenance of the private line shall be done by a licensed plumber upon a private service basis and the Village shall not furnish such service except in an emergency and then the owner of the service private line shall be charged the normal service rate existing at the time service is performed.

SEC. 9-4-2 WATER-RELATED FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES.

Pursuant to Sec. 196.03(3)(b), Wis. Stats., the Village of Marshall determines that this municipality and the Marshall Water Utility will continue to bill and pay for waterrelated fire protection services in the same manner as these services have been billed and paid for in the past until the Village Board adopts a subsequent resolution changing the method of billing and paying for these services. It is understood that any billing for these services on customers' water bills as allowed by law must be approved by the Marshall Village Board and by the Public Service Commission before the billing can be commenced.

SEC. 9-4-3 WATER METER WIRING. (Rev. 4/94'-Ord. 1994-7)

Eighteen (18) gauge, two (2) strand, electrical wiring shall be installed by a licensed electrician from the water meter to the outside reader prior to receiving a water meter for installation. A phone extension/jack shall be supplied and installed by a licensed electrician adjacent to the water meter prior to receiving a water meter for installation.

SEC. 9-4-4 CURB BOXES.

Curb boxes shall be raised above the ground level a minimum of six (6) inches. Property owners are responsible for the maintenance, repair and location of curb boxes. Property owners may be billed for failure to satisfy the requirements of this Section pursuant to Sec. 66.60(16), Wis. Stats.

SEC. 9-4-5 BACKWATER VALVE. *(Rev. 8/96'-Ord. 1996-9)*

All buildings shall have a backwater prevention valve and cleanout installed and maintained at the owner's expense prior to the location of the first fixture connection on the building sewer.
