1st Offense OWI/Hit & Run Accident

Marshall, WI. January 13, 2015 –

On December 24, 2014, Marshall Police Department arrested Dylan Brener, 22, of Oshkosh, for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1st Offense, Operating with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration and Hit and Run to Unattended Vehicle.

The traffic arrest occurred at approximately 10:10 pm after a complaint of a vehicle striking a parked vehicle and leaving the area was reported in the 200 blk of Evergreen Drive. The suspect and vehicle were located within a short distance of the accident scene. The Officer identified the driver as Dylan J Brener. The Officer smelt an odor of intoxicants coming from Brener and his speech was slurred along with being unstable on his feet. Brener submitted to field sobriety tests and an Intoximeter test reported a result of 0.18.

A 1st Offense OWI carries a fine of \$887.50, along with a mandatory 6 to 9 month revocation of driving privileges.
