Heroin Overdose Leads to Arrest of Dealers

Marshall, WI. January 12, 2015 – Heroin Overdose in the Village of Marshall leads to the arrest of multiple dealers in the Village of Marshall.

On Tuesday, December 2, 2014, at approximately 5:55 pm, Marshall Police Department, along with Marshall EMS, responded to the 200 block of Evergreen Boulevard for a 21-year-old male who was unresponsive inside the home from an overdose. He was transported to a local Hospital where he received treatment.

Officers found evidence of Heroin use and learned that Raymond J Long, 20, of Marshall, and Jessica L Espy, 21, of Marshall, were allegedly responsible for supplying the Heroin.

Long was arrested and booked into the Dane County Jail on the charges of Manufacture/Deliver Heroin, a Class F Felony. Long's next scheduled court appearance is Monday, January 26, 2015, for a Status Conference.

Espy was also arrested and booked into the Dane County Jail on the charges of Manufacture/Deliver Heroin, a Class F Felony. Espy's next scheduled court appearance is Monday, January 26, 2015, for a Status Conference.

A Class F Felony holds a penalty of up to 12.5 years of imprisonment, possibility of 5 years of extended supervision and up to a \$25,000 fine.
