SEXUAL ASSAULT WARRANT ISSUED

Marshall, WI. March 3, 2015 – Marshall Police Department filed an arrest warrant for the arrest of one subject in connection with a sexual assault complaint that the department has been investigating.

On February 24, 2015, an arrest warrant was issued for Prinston Hutchins, 30, of Marshall, through the Dane County District Attorney's Office for two (2) counts of 2nd Degree Sexual Assault of a Child under 16 years of age.

Hutchins allegedly sexually assaulted a 14 year old female victim over a three (3) month period of time in 2013/2014.

Hutchins also has a bench warrant for an unrelated case through the Marshall Police Department. Hutchins is being charged with Battery and Strangulation/Suffocation from an incident in November 2014 in the 100 block of Blue Spruce Lane. The Bench Warrant was issued after Hutchins failed to appear for his final Pre-Trial appearance.

If you know the whereabouts of Prinston Hutchins, please contact your local law enforcement agency. Hutchins is Male/Black, 5'08, approximately 145 lbs with brown eyes and black hair.

2nd Degree Sexual Assault of a Child under 16 years of age is a Class C Felony. Each Class C Felony holds a penalty of up to 40 years of imprisonment, possibility of 15 years of extended supervision and up to a \$100,000 fine.
