

**VILLAGE OF MARSHALL
ORDINANCE 2021-09**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 2, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 6
WARDS AND POLLING PLACES.**

WHEREAS, the Village is required to adjust Municipal Wards following the 2020 Federal Census; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.15, Wisconsin Statutes, requires that all cities, villages and towns with a population of 1,000 or more establish wards; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has reviewed proposed municipal wards

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that the proposed municipal wards will promote the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of Marshall, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Title 2-1-6 is hereby amended to read as follows: (Double Underlined areas are being added, strike through areas are being removed)

SEC. 2-1-6 WARDS AND POLLING PLACES. *(rev. 9/11/01, Ord. 2001-09, rev. 8/9/11, Ord. 2011-05, rev. 11/9/2021, Ord. 2021-09)*

(a) **Purpose.**

(1) Section 5.15, Wis. Stats. requires all cities, villages and towns with a population of one thousand (1,000) or more to establish municipal wards based on the results of the ~~2010~~ 2020 Federal census. Section 59.10(3)(b), Wis. Stats. requires that each county board adopt and transmit to each municipal governing body in the county a tentative county supervisory district plan, dividing the county into districts and designating the approximate location and population of each ward proposed to effectuate the division of the county into districts. These laws require that each municipality designate by consecutive whole number, geographical description and population, the various wards to be created within the municipality.

(b) **Adoption of Wards.** The Village of Marshall adopts the wards described as follows:

(1) Ward 1. Population ~~888~~ 885. Polling Place: 130 S. Pardee Street.

A portion of the Village bordering to the South of the centerline of Main Street (State Road 19) from the School Street/Main Street intersection to the most Eastern and Southern Village limits,

and all the areas lying South of the Madison Street/School Street Intersection to the most Western boundary of the Village limits to the most Southern Village limits,

and all areas lying North of the centerline of Main Street (State Road 19) to the most ~~southern~~ northern boundary of the Maunsha River from the Centerline of Lothe Street to the centerline of Hubbell street (Hwy 73 N) eastern border of the Maunsha River along the western lots of Maunsha Drive.

(2) Ward 2. Population 742-710. Polling Place: 130 S. Pardee Street

A portion of the Village bordering to the South of the centerline of Main Street (State Road 19) from School Street/Main Street Intersection to the most western boundary of the Village limits;

and all lands lying to the North of the centerline of Madison Street (County Hwy T) from the School Street/Madison Street intersection to the most western boundary of the Village limits;

and all areas bordering to the North of the centerline of Main Street (State Road 19) and west of Lothe Street, beginning at the intersection of Lothe Street & Main Street to the most Western boundary line of the Village limits and the most ~~southern~~ northern boundary line of the Maunsha River.

- (3) Ward 3. Population 800 748. Polling Place: 130 S. Pardee Street.

A portion of the Village bordering to the West of the centerline of Hubbell Street (State Road 73 N.) from the most Northern boundary of the Maunsha River to the Railroad tracks, to include all areas lying South of the Railroad Tracks to the Northern boundary of the Maunsha River; and to further include a portion of the Village to the North of the Railroad tracks known as Langer Park.

- (4) Ward 4. Population 864 877. Polling Place: 130 S. Pardee Street

All portions of the Village lying North of the Railroad tracks to the most Northern Village limits, except for Langer Park, which is in Ward three (3) and

All portions of the Village lying East of the Hubbell Street (Hwy 73 N.) centerline and south of the railroad to the centerline of Sunnyview Lane from the intersection of Hubbell Street to the east intersection of Water Tower Drive and then north along the east of the lots on Mourning Dove Court centerline of Water Tower Drive to the intersection of Mourning Dove Court and along all lots that front Mourning Dove Court to the southeast corner Lot located on Water Tower Drive and due east until the most eastern boundary line of the Village Limits

A portion of the Village lying south of the most southern boundary line of Ward 4, and lying East of the centerline of Hubbell Street and North of the centerline of Main Street (State Road 19) to the most eastern boundary line of the Village limits.

- (c) **Combined Wards.** All Wards created above are hereby combined for voting purposes, so as to share the common polling place indicated, and such combined wards shall use common ballot boxes and ballots or voting machines and separate returns shall not be maintained for the combined wards at any election, except where separate ballots are required under Sections 5.58 to 5.64, Wis. Statutes.
