

**VILLAGE OF MARSHALL
ORDINANCE 2022-05**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 2, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 4
PARKS COMMITTEE**

Ordinance amendment introduced by: The Parks and Recreation Director

Purpose of ordinance amendment: The proposed amendment will reduce the number of committee members from nine (9) voting members to five (5).

The Village Board of the Village of Marshall, Dane County, Wisconsin ordain as follows that Title 2, Chapter 4, Section 4 shall be amended as follows:

(Double underlined areas are being added, strike through areas are being removed)

Sec. 2-4-4 PARKS COMMITTEE. *(Rev. 06-14-22, Ord. 2022-05)*

- (a) **How Constituted.** The Parks Committee shall consist of ~~nine (9)~~ five (5) voting members, ~~three (3)~~ two (2) of whom shall be members of the Village Board and ~~five (5)~~ three (3) of whom shall be citizens; and ~~one (1) Marshall Fire Department member;~~ all citizen voting members shall be residents of the Village and the Marshall Fire Department voting member shall be a member of the Marshall Fire Department.
- (b) **Appointment.** The Village President, with approval of the Village Board, shall appoint the Village Board members who serve on the Parks Committee and the voting citizen members of the committee. ~~The Marshall Fire Department shall appoint the Marshall Fire Department member.~~ The Village President shall appoint one member as chairperson. The voting citizen members shall be selected upon expertise and knowledge.
- (c) **Terms.** *(rev. 4/93' Ord. 1993-7)* All voting members shall be appointed for staggered terms of three (3) years, effective May 1, annually. ~~The Fire Department member shall be appointed for one (1) year terms effective May 1, annually.~~
- (d) **Powers and Duties.** The members of the Parks Committee shall serve as an advisory body to the Village Board, making recommendations to said Board, and shall also be in charge of the day-to-day operation of parks within the Village of Marshall within policies and budgets adopted by the Village Board. It shall further be the duty of the Parks Committee to prepare a proposed annual budget for the parks, showing expenditures and revenues in a format directed by the Village Treasurer, for submission to the Village Board for its consideration by October 1 of each year. The Parks Committee is not a park board or commission as those terms are used in Chapter 27 of the Wisconsin Statutes and is not intended to have the powers or duties set forth in Section 27.08 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication provided by law.


