Search Warrant

Marshall, WI. January 12, 2015 – On Thursday, November 13, 2014, the Marshall Police Department, along with members of the Dane County Narcotics Task Force, and Dane County Sheriff's Office, executed a search warrant in the 900 block of Lewellen Street in the Village of Marshall, in regards to an ongoing drug investigation.

A search warrant was executed after a lengthy drug investigation regarding the address. Officers recovered numerous items of drug paraphernalia along with Heroin.

Based on the investigation conducted and evidence collected, Shannette L Short, 36, of Marshall, was charged with Maintaining a Drug Trafficking Place, a Class I Felony; Possession with Intent to Deliver – Heroin, a Class E Felony; and 3 Counts of Manufacture/Deliver Heroin, a Class F Felony. Short's next scheduled court appearance is Monday, January 26, 2015, for a Status Conference.

The investigation also led to Jessica L Espy, 21, of Marshall, being charged with 3 Counts of Manufacture/Deliver Heroin, a Class F Felony. Espy's next scheduled court appearance is Monday, January 26, 2015, for a Status Conference.

A Class E Felony holds a penalty of up to 15 years of imprisonment, possibility of 5 years of extended supervision and up to a \$50,000 fine. A Class F Felony holds a penalty of up to 12.5 years of imprisonment, possibility of 5 years of extended supervision and up to a \$25,000 fine. A Class I Felony holds a penalty of up to 3.5 years of imprisonment, possibility of 2 years of extended supervision and up to a \$10,000 fine.
