SUSPICIOUS PERSON

Marshall, WI. December 19, 2012 – The Marshall Police Department investigated an incident of a suspicious person in the 200 block of William Street.

On Wednesday, December 19, 2012, at approximately 8:40 am, Marshall Police Department Officer Joey Hoops witnessed an incident occur in the 200 block of William Street. Officer Hoops was on routine patrol when he witnessed a vehicle pull over and made contact with a 12 year old child. The Driver of the vehicle asked the child twice if they were interested in a ride to school. The Child declined to go with the driver and the driver left.

Officer Hoops was able to intervene in this incident and make contact with the child and followed up by contacting the sole occupant and driver of the vehicle. After further investigation, it was found that the Driver, though unknown to the child, is a parent of children in the school district and was concerned about the child walking to school.

Marshall Police Department's investigation found no intent of Child Enticement but did cite the Driver, a 33 year old Female, of Marshall, for Disorderly Conduct and Driving without a Valid Driver's License.

The Marshall Police Department would like to remind parents to take time with their children to remind them of Protective Behaviors.
