THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

Marshall, WI. February 23, 2015 – On Sunday, January 25, 2015, the Marshall Police Department responded to a complaint of a stolen automobile.

At approximately 4:10 pm, Marshall Police Department received a complaint of a stolen automobile from the 200 blk of Porter Street. The value of the stolen vehicle was approximately \$13,000.00.

At approximately 6:05 pm, Madison Police Department located the vehicle on John Nolan Drive. The Madison Officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle. The Suspect Driver, later identified as Scott White, attempted to elude officers. White was eventually stopped and taken into custody. White was booked into the Dane County Jail.

Marshall and Madison Police Department filed charges regarding this incident. Scott White, 46, of Janesville, was charged with Take and Drive a Vehicle without Owner's Consent, a Class H Felony; Attempting to Flee or Elude a Traffic officer and Obstructing an Officer, a Class I Felony; Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 4th Offense, a Class H Felony; Operate with a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration – 4th Offense, a Class H Felony and Operate a Motor Vehicle While Revoked, a Class U Misdemeanor.

A Class H Felony holds a penalty of up to 6 years of imprisonment, possibility of 3 years of extended supervision and up to a \$10,000 fine. A Class I Felony holds a penalty of up to 3.5 years of imprisonment, possibility of 2 years of extended supervision and up to a \$10,000 fine. A Class U Misdemeanor has a penalty of up to \$2500 and a driver's license suspension or revocation of up to 6 months.

White is scheduled to appear in Dane County Circuit Court on March 18, 2015, for a Final Pretrial Hearing. He is currently being held in the Dane County Jail.
