

Village of Marshall  
Yard Waste Disposal Regulations

1. Village of Marshall residents may dispose of grass clippings, garden refuse, and leaves in the bunker behind the public works garage at 515 Best Built Parkway at any time. Absolutely no containers, including plastic bags, may be left in the bunker. The public works crew will collect leaves placed curbside in plastic bags on each Wednesday from November 1 through November 30. Christmas trees will be chipped curbside each Wednesday from January 1 through January 31.
2. The Village of Marshall Public works crew will chip brush at curbside from April 1 through October 31, weather permitting. Starting April 1 of 2022, per village board directive, brush will be chipped at your property on Wednesday of the same week that your recyclables are collected. Absolutely no brush should be disposed of at the public works building. To control costs, the crew will not chip brush which is cut by professional tree trimmers, and will not spend more than ten minutes per week chipping at any individual property. The following rules should also be observed when placing brush curbside for chipping:
  - a. Branches to be chipped must not exceed eight inches in diameter.
  - b. Stack brush as neatly as possible with butt ends pointing in the same direction that traffic flows in the lane closest to your house. Do not cut branches shorter than 4 feet long.
  - c. Earth must be removed from bushes.
  - d. Completely segregate from garbage and other refuse.
  - e. Lengths under four feet, and/or less than ½ inch in diameter shall be bundled and tied with string, or placed in a container not exceeding 35 gallons in capacity. Bundles must not exceed 12 inches in diameter.
